Literary Analysis Essay

Compare and contrast the various families and familial networks that influence
 That was Then, This is Now. How do they bring people together, but also form
 boundaries? Pick three examples from the following: the Jennings, the Carlsons,
 the Shepards, and the hippie commune. The essay must be five paragraphs:
 introduction, three body paragraphs, and a conclusion. Include one direct quote
 in each paragraph as evidence.

Clever Connector

Your job is to find connections between the book and something else. The three main types of connections are:

- **Text-to-Text Connections:** Sometimes a story will make you think of another book, article, informational text, or primary source that you have read or heard about.
- Text-to-Self Connections: Sometimes a story will remind you about something that happened in your own life such as a birthday party, a vacation, a pet, a school event, etc. Sometimes, the text-to-self connection is about an event that happened in someone else's life such as an aunt, a friend, your pet, etc.
- **Text-to-World Connections:** Sometimes a story will make you think about something that is happening or has happened in the world.

Task Requirements: You will write a 5-7 sentence paragraph for each connection.
